St Kevin's Old Boys Football Club – Events Policy

Purpose: The purpose of the policy is to define what constitutes a Club Event to assist organisers and the Club in managing the risks inherent in events (particularly those held outside the club rooms). The policy also aims to optimise benefits and reduce risks for club sponsors who make their venues available for Club Events.

Club Events defined: A Club Event is one that organised by delegated club players or members and sanctioned by the Club (or its senior, delegated Committee members: President, Vice President, Secretary or Treasurer), held in a club managed venue (ie. TH King, Righetti Oval or St Kevins College Heyington or Tooronga pavilions) or in a venue run by a club sponsor and expressly accepted as an event by that venues management.

For the avoidance of doubt - gatherings of players, members or supporters at a venue before, after or separate to an official club sanctioned event is NOT a Club approved or sanctioned Event.

All attendees are expected to abide by the club Code of Conduct at all Club Events.

In addition, if players, members and supporters gather for non sanctioned gatherings (particularly if they are readily identifiable as members of SKOB via apparel etc) we expect attendees to abide by our Code of Conduct.
